DATE: 30 August 2008 - MATCHES 1-4, OF THE 1000 POINT AGGREGATE CHAMPIONSHIP
31 August 2008 – MATCH 5 OF THE 1000 POINT AGGREGATE, FOLLOWED BY THE
EXCELLENCE IN COMPETITION (EIC) MATCH

TIME: FIRING WILL COMMENCE AT **0800 EACH DAY**, PITS SEAL AT **0745**.

LOCATION: **RANGE #3**, CAMP SMITH, PEEKSKILL, NY - LOCATED ON ROUTES 6 & 202, 3 MILES
EAST OF THE BEAR MOUNTAIN BRIDGE.

SQUADDING: THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH WILL BE SQUADED AT 0700 ON 30 AUGUST
(LATE REGISTRATIONS DONE AT THIS TIME). COMPETITORS FOR THE EIC
MATCH WILL BE REGISTERED AND SQUADED FOLLOWING THE TEAM MATCH
ON 31 AUGUST. THE MATCH DIRECTORS MATCH WILL BE FIRED
CONCURRENTLY WITH THE EIC MATCH.

RULES: 2007 NRA HIGH POWER RIFLE RULES (with changes).

CLASSIFICATIONS: NRA CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM WILL BE USED. UNCLASSIFIED
COMPETITORS WILL FIRE IN THE MASTER CLASS.

ELIGIBILITY: OPEN TO ALL COMPETITORS. NY STATE RESIDENTS **MUST** BE MEMBERS OF THE
NYSRPA. NON-RESIDENTS **MUST** BE MEMBERS OF THEIR STATE ASSOCIATION.
NON-NRA MEMBERS COMPETING WILL BE PLACED IN MASTER CLASSIFICATION

SIGHTING SHOTS: IN SLOW FIRE STAGE MAY BE TAKEN OR WAIVED, RULE 9.2(c), IN RAPID
FIRE IF NOT TAKEN WILL BE RECORDED AS MISSES IN SPACE FOR RECORDING
SIGHTERS (RULE 9.2.(d).

TARGETS: NRA APPROVED TARGETS WILL BE USED.

MATCH OFFICIALS: WILL BE ASSIGNED BY THE MATCH DIRECTOR.

SAFETY: **SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT. EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI) MUST BE VISIBLE IN
THE RIFLE CHAMBER AND MAGAZINES REMOVED WHEN RIFLES ARE UNCASSED.**

FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION !

- GENERAL:** ALL COMPETITORS WILL SCORE AND OPERATE TARGETS AS ASSIGNED. **PAID TARGET PULLERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.**
- MATCH #1:** 2 SIGHTING SHOTS, 20 SHOTS FOR RECORD, STANDING, SLOW FIRE, 200 YARDS, 22 MINUTES, SR TARGET.
- MATCH #2:** 2 SIGHTING SHOTS, 20 SHOTS FOR RECORD, SITTING OR KNEELING FROM STANDING, RAPID FIRE, 200 YARDS, 2 - 10 SHOT STRINGS, 60 SECONDS PER STRING, SR TARGET.
- MATCH #3:** 2 SIGHTING SHOTS, 20 SHOTS FOR RECORD, PRONE FROM STANDING, RAPID FIRE, 300 YARDS, 2 - 10 SHOT STRINGS, 70 SECONDS PER STRING, SR-3 TARGET.
- MATCH #4:** 2 SIGHTING SHOTS, 20 SHOTS FOR RECORD. PRONE, SLOW FIRE, 500 YARDS, TIME LIMIT 22 MINUTES, MR-65 TARGET.
- MATCH #5:** 2 SIGHTING SHOTS, 20 SHOTS FOR RECORD. PRONE, SLOW FIRE, 500 YARDS, TIME LIMIT 22 MINUTES, MR-65 TARGET.
- MATCH #6:** THE NY STATE HIGH POWER RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP. AN AGGREGATE OF THE SCORES FIRED IN MATCHES # 1 THROUGH #5
- F-CLASS:** **F-CLASS COMPETITORS WILL BE SQUADED FOR MATCHES #4 & 5, AWARDS TBD (IF LARGE ENOUGH PARTICIPATION)**

UNCLASSIFIED COMPETITORS COMPETE IN THE MASTER CLASS.

PROPERTY RULES/ FINAL ACTIONS

TRASH RECEPTACLES WILL BE PROVIDED IN THE PIT AREA AND AT EACH YARD LINE. **BRASS BOXES** WILL BE AT EACH TOWER FOR **YOUR EXPENDED BRASS.**

SPEED LIMIT IS 20 MPH. FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN HAVING THE VIOLATOR AND THEIR VEHICLE REMOVED FROM THE CAMP PROPERTY.

EXCELLENCE IN COMPETITION MATCH (EIC)

DATE: 31 AUGUST 2008, EIC MATCH WILL COMMENCE APPROXIMATELY 1100 HOURS.

ELIGIBILITY: ALL U. S. CITIZENS, 14 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

ENTRY LIMIT: ONE HUNDRED FORTY (140) COMPETITORS. ENTRY PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO NON-DISTINGUISHED COMPETITORS. NO ONE MAY FIRE THIS MATCH FOR PRACTICE.

ENTRY: ENTRIES ACCEPTED AT 200 YARD LINE COMMENCING AS NOTED ABOVE. **NO ADVANCE ENTRIES ACCEPTED - DO NOT MAIL IN ENTRIES FOR THIS MATCH.**

SPECIAL NOTICE: IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE CIVILIAN MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM (CMP), EACH COMPETITOR **MUST** COMPLETE AN *ELIGIBILITY AFFIDAVIT AND LIABILITY AGREEMENT* PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE MATCH.

ENTRY FEE: **FEE FOR THIS MATCH IS \$35.00. DO NOT MAIL IN EIC ENTRY FEES WITH YOUR REGISTRATION CARD (SR-1).**

RIFLE: SERVICE RIFLE ONLY. RULES 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3. US RIFLE M-1, CALIBER 30 OR 7.62 MODIFIED, US RIFLE M-14, CALIBER 7.62 OR COMMERCIAL EQUIVALENT, US RIFLE M-16, CALIBER 5.56 OR COMMERCIAL EQUIVALENT.

AMMUNITION: ALL COMPETITORS MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN AMMUNITION FOR USE IN THIS MATCH.

AWARDS: MEDALS WILL BE AWARDED BY THE CMP TO THE FIRST THREE PLACES. CREDIT TOWARDS THE DISTINGUISHED RIFLEMAN BADGE WILL BE AWARDED TO CIVILIAN COMPETITORS BY THE CMP AND TO MILITARY COMPETITORS THROUGH THEIR RESPECTIVE SERVICE HEADQUARTERS.

COURSE OF FIRE: THE NATIONAL MATCH COURSE (NO SIGHTING SHOTS)

STAGE 1: 10 SHOTS, SLOW FIRE, STANDING, 200 YARDS, 10 MINUTES

STAGE 2: 10 SHOTS, RAPID FIRE, STANDING TO SITTING OR KNEELING, 200 YARDS, 60 SECONDS

STAGE 3: 10 SHOTS, RAPID FIRE, STANDING TO PRONE, 300 YARDS, 70 SECONDS

STAGE 4: 20 SHOTS, SLOW FIRE, PRONE, 500 YARDS, 20 MINUTES

Notice: In accordance with NRA rules (11.1) the Match Director may change the match and/or firing conditions as shown in the program provided.

MATCH DIRECTORS MATCH: The National Match course of fire, to be fired simultaneously with the EIC Match. A **NO** sighter match for Match Rifle competitors, with no awards.
